# EKLC Council Meeting Minutes

**July 20th, 2020**

Meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM. Those in attendance were Chris Frodel, Pastor Brenda, Tom Locchetta, Sonja Jacobson, Hans Lien and Jason Schlieckau.

Opened with devotions and a prayer by Pastor Brenda.

Financial updates, Memorials, Profit Loss statement, Money Market account reports were presented by Judy Lund. Lois Heise memorial was placed in undesignated funds. Robert Furseth memorial designation changed. Designation is for children's choir or any expenses related to Sunday school. Profit Loss statement indicates expenses and profits are down, likely due to Covid. Year to date gross profit down approximately \$23,000. Judy will include total income and total expenses in newsletter.

The church is not able to receive funds from a PPE loan at this time. Government not accepting applications at the time the application was created and submitted.

Motion to approve financial reports made by Tom, seconded by Hans, approved and passed.

Minutes from June meeting, submitted by Jason Schlieckau, reviewed. The following submitted reports were also reviewed: Education Committee and Pastor's report. Motion to approve reports and minutes made by Tom and seconded by Sonja.

"Playground" discussed. Funds to come from undesignated memorials. Each member of council inspected the future area of the playground location in the back of church, and approved of the location.

## Old Business

New contract for webmaster discussed and approved by council. The contract was deemed a very good value.

New church logo discussed. The current logo is simple yet very effective. Council decided to keep current logo, and instead, clean up the graphic. Tom to look into this.

COVID Discussion

It was determined that August 2<sup>nd</sup> will be the first date for return to in-church worship. The service will continue to be recorded for internet streaming for those that wish to view from home. Proper precautions will be followed, including, but not limited to: ushers directing people to their seats, bagged Communion wafer/wine, single church entrance/exit points, and available thermometer in entry of church. Tom and Jason to usher and Sonja to greet for this service. All names of those in attendance will be recorded upon entry into church, for notification and future tracking if needed.

The future of Sunday school was discussed. Survey to go out to Sunday school families to determine comfort level of their children attending. Depending on how many families commit will determine what area of the church basement Sunday school will be held.

## New Business

Tax assessment on parsonage. Hans to find out why assessment is higher than all other homes around, and dispute this on the 7/30. He will be going to the board.

Discussed parsonage and rent.

Church Mutual insurance company walk-thru discussed. Pastor to contact the company regarding a past open claim that should be closed.

## **EKLC COVID-19 Worship Guidelines**

We are excited to begin worshipping in person. As we welcome you back to church, know that personal responsibility is key - any member who is feeling ill or compromised should not attend services. We caution those in the age group (65+) of higher risk to use your best judgment if you should be attending services.

We will continue to live stream services on Facebook and YouTube for those who do not yet feel comfortable attending in person. All members need to be mindful of social distancing, washing hands, and wearing masks to create a safe place to worship.

- **Attendees: Phase 2: 50% occupancy – 110 persons (Phase 3: 75% occupancy - 170))**

- ◇ Enter through Narthex doors only. All others will be locked.
- ◇ Doors will be opened by a greeter or will be propped open.
- ◇ Members must not congregate before or after services.
- ◇ Members are required to wear a mask during worship to help ensure the health and safety of the rest of the congregation.

- **Seating:**

- ◇ Every other pew will be blocked off to ensure social distance.
- ◇ Ushers will direct members to an area to sit and will usher out by pews at the end of the service.
- ◇ Families may sit together
- ◇ Others must be 6 ft apart from other members.

- **Worship:**

- ◇ There will be no singing during worship in Phase 2 (Phase 3 is TBD).
- ◇ Bulletins will be distributed with all content in them and pew Bibles and hymnals will be removed. **Ushers handing out bulletins will wear gloves.**
- ◇ During Passing of the Peace you will not leave your seat nor shake hands.
- ◇ Offering will be collected in baskets in the Narthex.
- ◇ Communion will only be held during the first service of the month and will be distributed **with gloves** upon entrance to the sanctuary.

- **Common Areas:**

- ◇ Restrooms directly below the Narthex will be open for use.
- ◇ The following common areas will be closed to members:
- ◇ Friendship Hall
- ◇ Nursery
- ◇ Kitchen
- ◇ Offices (Staff Only)
- ◇ Education Wing

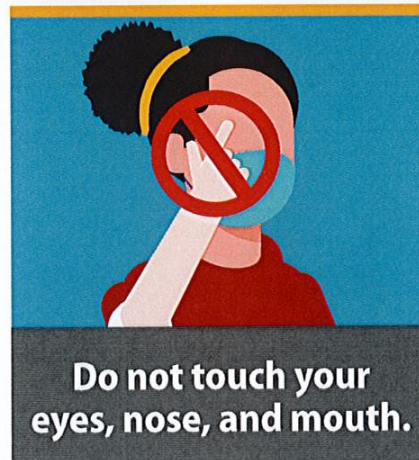
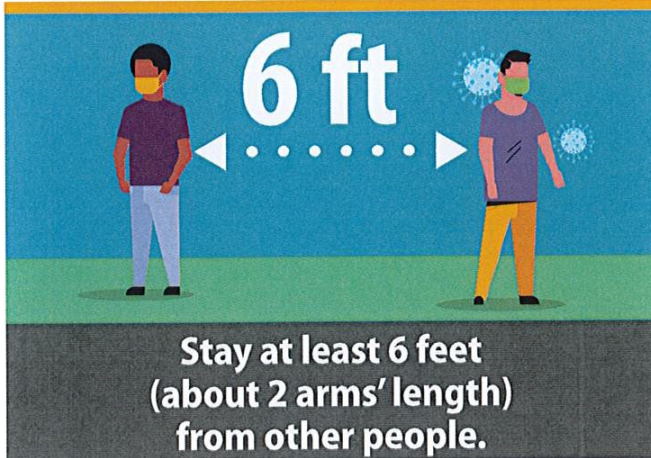
**If there is a confirmed positive COVID case from a member that has attended worship, the church will:**

- Notify those in attendance of a member testing positive for COVID via phone call
- Send an email to all members notifying them of the positive result
- That information will include:
  - ◇ Date of service
  - ◇ A reminder of next steps (see subsequent bullets)
  - ◇ No other identifying information about the member will be shared
- If you are contacted via phone:
  - ◇ Monitor your symptoms at home, and decide if you should self-quarantine for the 14 day period
  - ◇ If you feel ill, see your primary care provider for a COVID test or use the [public health](#) testing options in your area.
  - ◇ Notify the Property Committee and the church will be sanitized using the cleaning protocol.

Bake in mod. oven at 350 degrees

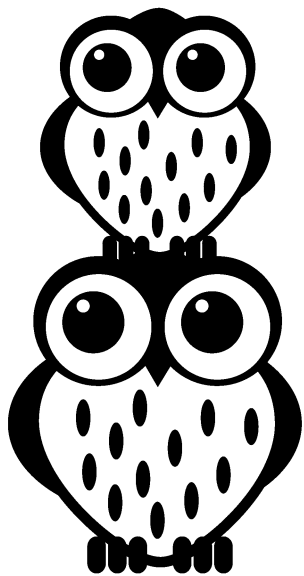

Design a handy bag to tote your books this fall.

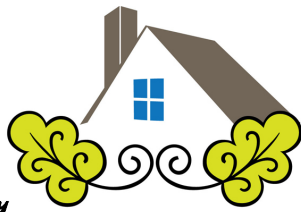
### What you need:

### What you do:

1. Lay the bag flat on a table, and place cardboard inside for protection.
2. Pour a paint dollop on each plate.
3. Slice the apple in half, keeping the core intact.
4. Brush a thin layer of paint on the cut side of an apple half. Practice making stamps on scrap paper. Use the other color on the other apple half.
5. Paint and stamp the bag with your final design. When dry, remove the cardboard.
6. Use the bag for school and Sunday school. Happy reading!

## **What to expect on Sunday Morning**

Please contact the church office if you want to receive a paper copy of our bulletin. Now that we are using the building for worship again, we will stop the weekly bulletin mailings. We will send them to you if you request it. Thank you!

As we gather together for worship in the building since the beginning of March, we want to make sure that you are prepared for what to expect. These are measures that are taken to be as safe as possible during the pandemic.

- Only the front narthex door will be open. The other doors into the building will be locked.
- A greeter will open the door for you.
- Masks are required to wear unless it's not possible in the case of medical necessity, per county public health orders.
- You are not required to take temperatures, but if you would like your temp taken, equipment will be available.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the door.
- Offering plate will be at the front door.
- Ushers will hand out bulletins wearing gloves.
- On Communion Sundays (first Sunday of the month), an usher wearing gloves will hand you a wafer in a ziplock baggie and a salad dressing cup or wine or grape juice.
- An usher will walk you to a pew. The sanctuary will be filled from front to back, so you won't be able to choose the pew you sit in.
- You will sit in your pew for the entire worship service.
- Every other pew will be marked off so you only sit in open pews.
- No singing in worship.
- No shaking hands
- Communion will be taken in the pews with the elements you picked up in the narthex.
- At the end of the service, you'll be ushered out from back to front and leave through the narthex door.
- Bathrooms will be used one family at a time, so please wait spaced out in a line outside of the bathroom door. After using the bathroom, take a Chlorox clean up wipe to wipe down all of the surfaces that you and your family touched.
- There will be no fellowship hour and no coffee.

These all might seem like drastic measures, but we want to be sure to do all we can to be safe and follow guidelines given by the CDC and county public health. Thank you for your cooperation in this.
