Friends in Christ,

Wow, I can't believe yet another summer is coming to an end and the fall season will be here soon. Fall is often a time when church programing resumes once again, and that's the case here with Sunday School and Confirmation starting back up soon. I know I'm looking forward to it and I'm sure many of you are too. I have some wonderful memories not only from teaching Sunday School and Confirmation classes, but also from going through them back when I was a child. One of those memories came from a class that was being taught by one of my aunts who shared a story with us from her time working as a speech pathologist with the Rockford Public School District for several decades. This was a story about one student who was bullying another student who had intellectual disabilities. She knew the whole family of the kid who was doing the bully and also knew that they were very devout Roman Catholics, who went to mass every week. So knowing that my aunt confronted this student about what he was doing and asked how he reconciled his faith with demeaning another human being. He then explained that when he was in worship he behaved faithfully and always asked his priest for forgiveness for the ways he behaved unfaithfully outside of worship. With that my aunt discovered that this boy seemed to believe that it was ok to have a dichotomy, completely separating his faith from his daily life. I've seen many other people who have similar views, but that is simply not correct. God calls us to live as the church, in every single part of our lives! In other words, we can never separate our faith lives from any other part of our lives; i.e. our social life, our finances, our jobs, our family, our hobbies, and so on. Our faith should inform **Pas**our decisions, our finances, how we participate in our democracy, and so on. Who we are in worship is who God calls us to be in every part of our lives. That lesson has always stuck with me since Sunday School and I hope it's one that will stick with all of you as well.

Ukraine dinner Held August 5th



JULY visitors at East Koshkonong Church - A large gathering of descendants of Sophia (1876-1930) and Christian Helgestad (1871-1927) met at the East Koshkonong Church on Thursday, July 27th to welcome six of their relatives from Norway. The Norwegian visitors were: Hilde Iversbakken, Mathilde Hanssen, Raimond Strømvall, Kathinka Hanssen, Josefine Hanssen and Kristian Hanssen — from Kapp, a small town about two hours' drive from Oslo. These intrepid travelers are the descendants of Sophia Helgestad's sister, Johanne Syversen (1867-1945), who remained in Norway. Sophia and Christian Helgestad, members of our church in the early part of the 20th century, had 11 children in total. Three of those 11 children had descendants represented at the gathering: Borghild (wife of John Rude), Alma (wife of Russell Wilcox) and Florence (wife of Leonard Horn). Borghild (1904-1975) and John Rude (1900-1997) are buried at East Koshkonong.

East Koshkonong Church volunteer Bonnie Ehrke gave the group a guided tour of the two church buildings and explained some of EKLC's fascinating history. The Norwegian family members were especially interested to read the Norwegian inscriptions in the windows of the upper church and in the kitchen of the lower church. The Norwegians also visited the graves of their ancestor's siblings, Sophia Helgestad and her brother Hans Hanson, who are buried at East Koshkonong (see photo).
