Financials: Judy answered questions regarding financials. The Ukraine fund has \$818.75. Peggy made a motion to write a check to Natasha for her to forward to her family in the Ukraine for use as needed for refuges and other needs in the area. Motion 2nd by Linda. Motion carried. A donation was made to EKLC from the estate of Rodell Lee in the amount of \$25,000. Oren made a motion to approve the financials as presented. 2nd by Linda. Motion carried.

Brian Luther will grind the stump and Bryar will clean up chips and add topsoil. A1 will return to trim other tree branches hanging over addition roof. Also, ask them to trim up pines hanging over drive/parking area.

Furnace filters are scheduled for 3 month delivery. They will be replaced on a consistent basis.

The sink in the sacristry has been repaired.

Bryar reached out to people for quote on window repair.

Getting a quote from AI Beyers for electronic thermostat controls.

Lights on front of church have been fixed. Will address lighting on east side parking area.

Rope for bell tower needs to be replaced.

Someone will being contacting NCI regarding repairs to the bell towers.

Council members walked outside to review sidewalk and drainage issues that Bryar proposes to repair.
